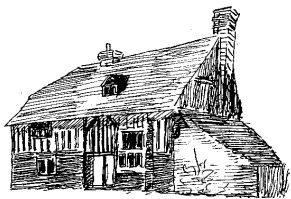


Uckfield and District Preservation Society Ltd

The Society was formed in 1968, initially to protect and preserve Nutley Windmill and to encourage interest in the local environment. In 1983 it took over and renovated Bridge Cottage as a Heritage Centre on behalf of the Uckfield Town Council. Since that time the Society has continued to expand its activities and now publishes both a Newsletter three times a year and an annual research journal – *Hindsight*. In addition it also produces a number of information books and leaflets and supports and encourages local interest in the environment.

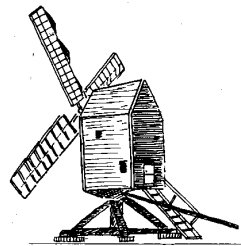
In establishing close links with the Town Council and other organisations, it has a good reputation as an important source of opinion and advice in the local history and environmental fields. These links ensure we can help to monitor and comment on various local and district planning matters. Within the Society we have a **Local History Group** who organise a programme of winter talks and summer outings all with a local bias. Our **Nutley Mill Group** focuses on maintaining the mill to a high level of working order and welcomes visits and assistance in running this unique heritage site.

The Society is a Voluntary Charity that depends upon the support of its members. New members are always welcome and for details please ring **01825 733 711**.



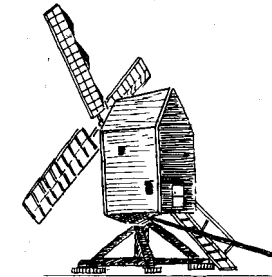
BRIDGE COTTAGE

Built around 1436, this important Wealden Medieval timber-framed house now forms the local Heritage Centre. Leased from the Town Council, the building hosts many local activities whilst the Society carries out a continuous programme of improvements.



NUTLEY WINDMILL

Built around 1700, although parts have been dated to c.1550, this working post mill is open to the public during the summer months. The work carried out by the Society has earned grants from BT and B&Q and a European Heritage Award.

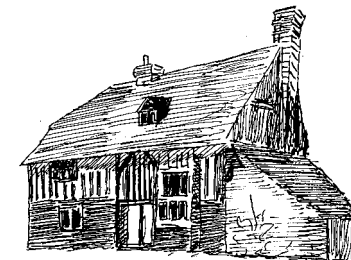


NUTLEY WINDMILL
